It takes a close and personal look at issues such as social networking, online chat, mobiles, games and learning and studying online.

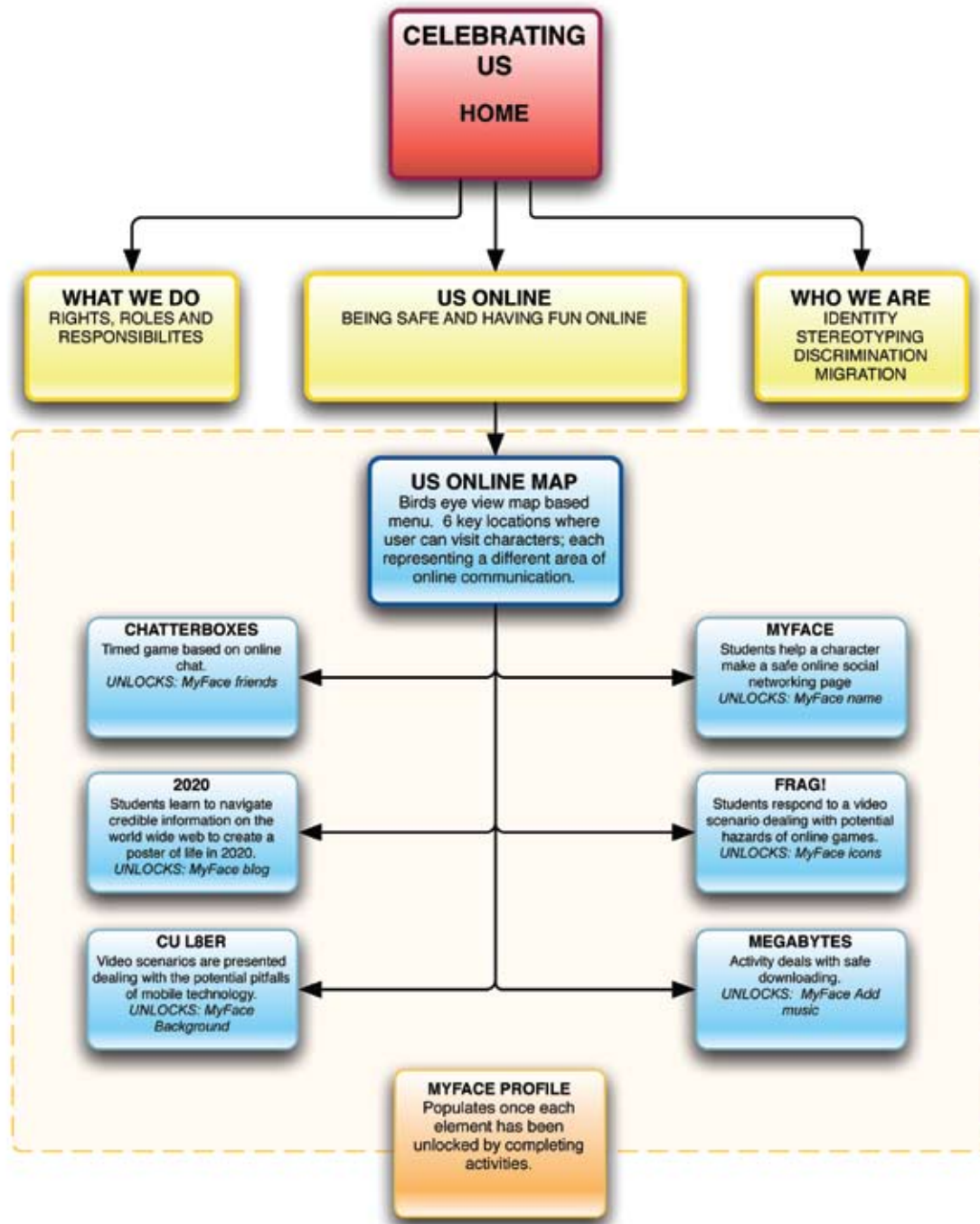

Who is it for?

Technical requirements

All a teacher needs is a web browser with Flash Player (VERSION 9) that can be downloaded free from Adobe (www.adobe.com). The **CELEBRATING US** modules function in all Virtual Learning Environments.

Each school, LA or Grid can install the modules on their own servers. Roar Educate support staff will assist in supplying the necessary technical specifications to ensure smooth delivery.

As **CELEBRATING US** involves extensive student activities and supports the sharing of student

created content, issues of security are important. The modules support a Shibboleth (security authentication standard) environment if required.
