What is it?

RE*CREATE is the easy way for teachers to create and distribute their very own digital learning activities from a rich library of video, sound and images.

Why Learning Activities?

Learning activities are a great way for pupils to engage with topics in the curriculum, as they are required to actively participate in a task and to apply as well as acquire knowledge.

How does it work?

RE*CREATE is accessed over the Internet via a unique login for each teacher.

The teacher starts with his or her chosen topic or area, then selects a professional role for the pupils (with great roles to choose from like Filmmaker, Curator and Reporter) and then assembles video, audio and image clips from the extensive library to make up the project. The teacher is guided through each step with simple wizards and helpful instructions.

Once the activity is created a teacher can download the activity or easily publish it to a Learning Platform or interactive whiteboard.

RE*CREATE is an ideal product for teachers of pupils across Key Stages 1- 4. With the breadth of professional roles and the wealth of digital resources it can be used for almost all curriculum areas but is most appropriate for:

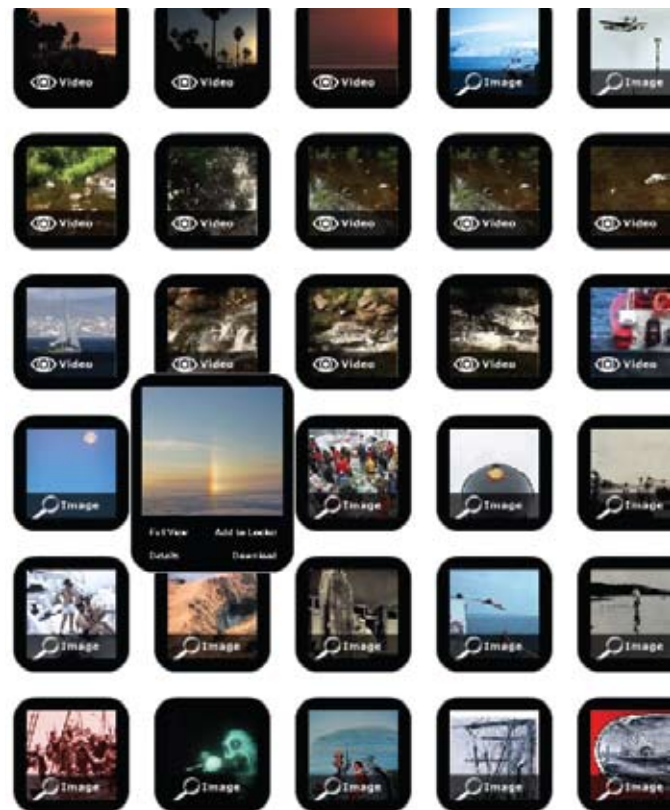
