- What happens when rights come into conflict with responsibilities?

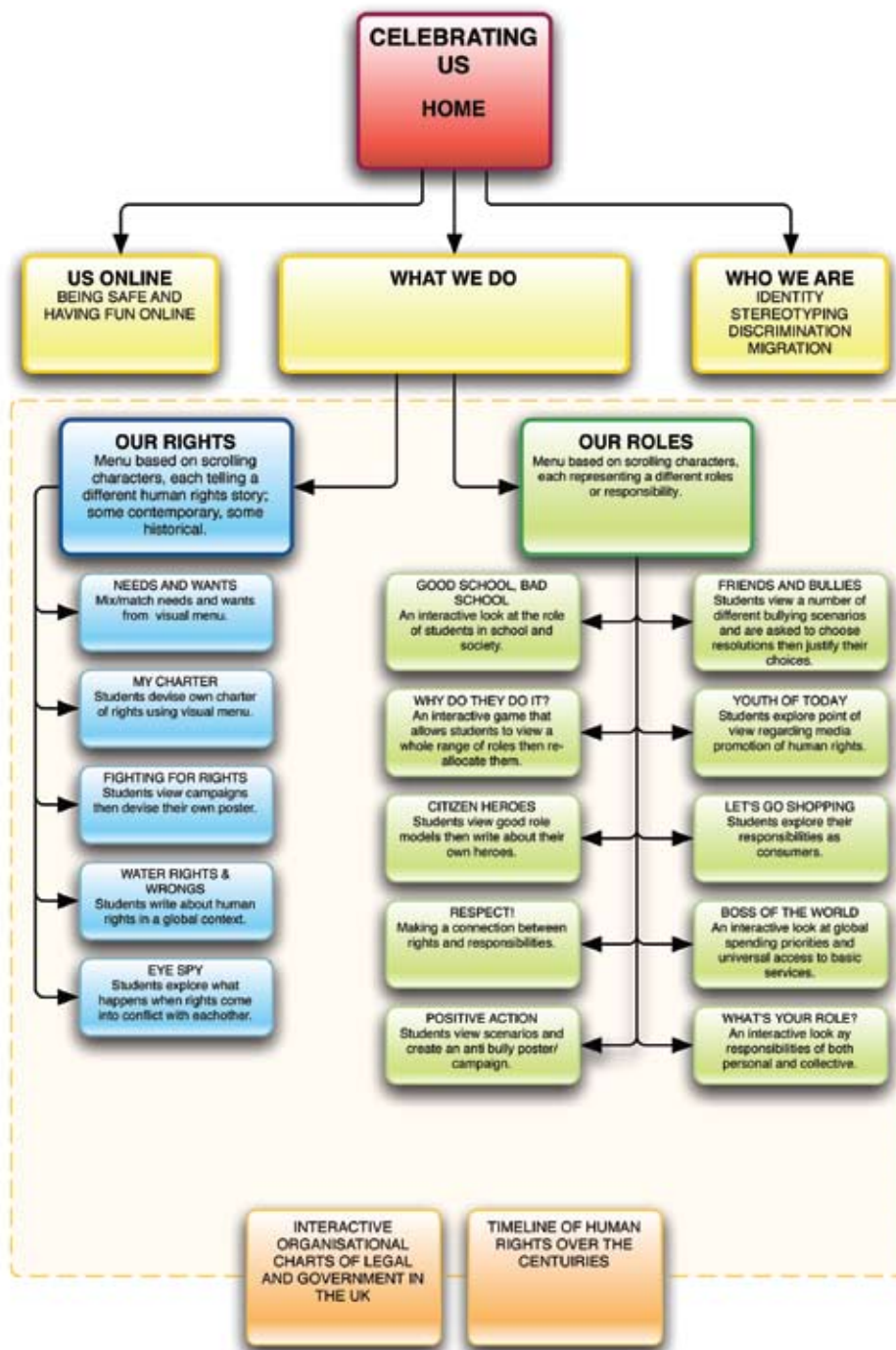
